Subject: Service Provider Survey on Administrative Costs

Spending

The survey is for Canada-Ontario Job Grant (COJG), Skills Development Fund (SDF), SkillsAdvance Ontario (SAO), Literacy and Basic Skills (LBS), Local Boards and Ontario Bridge Training Program (OBTP) service providers only.

In 2019-20, the Ministry conducted an internal audit with respect to the treatment of administrative funding in transfer payment agreements (TPAs) for Employment Ontario (EO) programs. Findings suggested the need to define a clear rationale for the allowable levels of administrative costs, and detailed data collection for how administrative funds are spent. In response to these recommendations the Ministry has committed to:

- document the rationale to support the category of expenses that are to be included as administrative costs in the TPAs; and
- specify the maximum allowable amount that can be spent on each of the expense types.

To fulfill the recommendations, the Ministry is sending a <u>survey</u> to service providers and conducting stakeholder consultations to gather primary data and insights on administrative costs spending by service providers. This two-step process will inform and support the Ministry to develop an administrative cost policy for EO programs, which are out of scope for the Employment Services Transformation initiative.
