OJCP Projects:

- Provide participants with opportunities to obtain meaningful work experience.
- Provide participants with enhanced employability skills.
- Benefit the community and / or the local economy.
- Consist of activities that are finite in length and incremental to the sponsor normal operations.

Eligibility

Eligible Sponsors

- Not-for-profit organizations
- Municipalities
- Indigenous councils, institutions, and organizations
- Public health and educational institutions
- Businesses

Eligible Participants

- · Be a resident of Ontario and,
- Meet the EI Act's definition of an "insured participant". An "insured participant" includes: a person for whom an EI benefit period is established; a person whose EI benefit period has ended within the previous 60 months; a person who paid, in at least 3 of the last 10 years, employee's premiums (where earnings have been at least \$2000 in each of those years); and a person who was in receipt of the employment insurance emergency

- response benefit within the previous 60 months.
- Be unemployed. Individuals are considered unemployed if they: work less than an average of 20 hours per week and are actively seeking full-time employment.
