Report (DSQR) Calculation Methodology for Service Coordination

and Suitability Indicators

The purpose of this memorandum is to advise Supported Employment (SE) service providers of changes to the calculation methodology of the Service Coordination and Suitability indicators in the SE DSQR Report.

Prior to 2021-2022 fiscal year, the Suitability and Service Coordination indicators calculations erroneously excluded carryover clients in their denominator. The calculation methodology changed in the Spring of 2021 and as a result, the carryover client counts started being included for both indicators.

After review, and to keep with the original intent and design of the SE program, the calculations are now adjusted as follows, and will be reflected in the May 2022 DSQR:

- For the **Suitability Indicator**, the carryover clients will be excluded from the calculation.
- For the **Service Coordination Indicator**, the carryover clients will continue to be included in the calculations.

The May and June 2022 DSQR were released and available for your use on June 17th, 2022.
