The Ontario government continues to modernize and simplify service delivery for skilled tradespeople and apprentices by completing the transfer of functions from the province to Skilled Trades Ontario (STO) as of April 2, 2025.

Beginning April 2, 2025, STO will oversee the registration of training agreements for OYAP participants and sponsor authorization. All other OYAP responsibilities remain with the ministry.

To assist you with this transition, the Ministry has posted OYAP process guides, updated OYAP Participant Application, and question and answer documents here: EOPG Ontario Youth Apprenticeship Program (OYAP). These new processes and procedures are effective April 2, 2025.
